Mark is ready to hand over the city manager classification to his successor, Ellen Richter, one of our newer club members. Growing up, Mark lived in Minneapolis and graduated from Benilde-St. Margaret High School in 1968. He started out in college wanting to major in dentistry, but organic chemistry was his undoing. So city management it was, in Waseca, St. Louis Park, and White Bear Lake. He stated that City Manager as a profession changes from "what you do" to "what you are" over time. Mark and wife Maureen recently took a 6,700 mile retirement journey of over a month camping in various national parks, sleeping in two person tent. This was a test of their love for one another and they are still together! They do love to travel and San Francisco is the most frequent destination where both children, Elliot and Monica, live with their families. They have four grandsons who are political activists already. Other past vacations have many times involved detours on Mark's part to visit that city's waste treatment plant or public works facilities. Mark loved his work as City Manager and his team of co-workers. Thanks Mark for your service to the city and for your continuing "service above self" in the club. Ashley Filipp, White Bear Lake Area YMCA and WBL Rotarian PROGRAM: Ashley started working with the YMCA in Boston at the Charlestown Y, worked at the San Diego YMCA and is currently the Branch Director of the YMCA here in town. Her husband also works for the YMCA organization. YMCA started in London in 1844 as a home away from home for sailors. The Y's U.S. roots are in Boston, the first location being Old South Church. The Y inspired the formation of USO, Peace Corps, and Father's Day as well as ESL courses. Present day in the Twin Cities, the Y is the largest provider of child care. The Y camping movement is very well established. The Y in WBL was first established in the downtown area. Swimming lessons first happened at the lake in Mahtomedi. One priority of the Y is "No one should drown" and senior and the immigrant populations are big in swimming lessons. Another priority is connection to youth and youth outreach. They aim to meet families where they are and fill gaps where needed. Since Nov. 1, the WBL Area YMCA has taken over management of the Maplewood Community Center. Your WBL Area Y membership is good there too now. Our Y has a goal to provide \$400,000 in financial aid in 2017. The WBL Area Y gave 2,000 scholarships for membership and participation in 2016. They are still a little bit short of the fundraising goal for the coming year. Our Y currently has approximately 5,000 members. Thank you Ashley for sharing your story of YMCA with us!
