Ken introduced Lynne Megan, DG-Elect, from the Roseville club and Chain of Lakes . Lynne introduced Jim who focused on values and service.

The foundation of our values is the four way test. Then there are core values: fellowship, friendship, leadership, integrity, service, community.

Cap that off with our value of service above self.

The Rotary circle starts with service - projects and outcomes (the things we do); which leads into public image; which leads to membership; which leads to the Rotary Foundation (which drives the humanitarian service that we do); which leads back to service.

Polio is Rotary’s number one strategic imperative and membership is how Rotary gets things done. As a club, White Bear is doing well but a net increase in membership is still a goal.

The Rotary Foundation is celebrating its 100th year and is worth about \$1 billion. The dollars are used for the polio work, yourh exchange, and more. The foundation is Jim’s charity of choice due to its focus and efficiency (.92 cents of each dollar donated goes to projects). Rotary Foundation was rated in the top 10 (#5) of foundations worldwide for focus and efficiency.

Jim asked members to donate annually to the foundation with a goal per member of \$26.50. The foundation isn’t so much about the money, it’s about the impact of what we do - children who do not have polio, people who have clean water, youth exchange experience, etc.

Jim asked members to take the note cards on the table and write a thank you to someone for their service, or an invitation to someone to join Rotary. He asked members to address the envelopes and mail the cards.

Rotary Serving Humanity is the theme this year.

Jim shared District 5960 2016-17 events scheduled including the Rotary Foundation Celebration 100 Years on Nov. 12 in St. Paul; One Rotary Summit/Mid-Term Jan 14, 2017 at Hamline University; 2017 District Conference with speaker David Law on April 28, 2017.

Reminder - membership and foundation are goals for the year.

Finally, Jim thanked members for all they do.

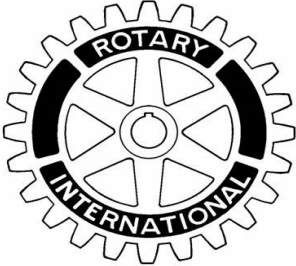
