PROGRAM FROM MEETING OF 9/28/22:
Off site Meeting at Rotary Nature Preserve

Connie Taillon and Andy Wieteki updated the club on a multi-year cooperative project of the Club and the City of White Bear Lake to remove invasive plants and replace them with native plants in several phases. The first phase was initiated over the past few months with mechanical and chemical removal of invasive plants near the parking lot and paved trail and, more recently, with the planting of native species plants by Rotarians. This phase will continue to be expanded in the same general area. The cost is being shared by the Club, the City, the Vadnais Lake Area Water Management Organization.

Connie and Andy conducted a tour of portions of the preserve that are scheduled for removal of invasive trees and other plants and replacement with native vegetation over the next three years.
