Stevie Ray's presentation to our club dealt with how to persuade and influence people. There are 2 methods of persuasion: (1) if your audience is in agreement, then state the conclusion followed by the evidence; and (2) if you are not sure whether your audience agrees or not, state the evidence followed by the conclusion. It is good to start with something that everyone can agree on and then move to what you want to accomplish. Try not to use the trigger words of "but" or "however". These trigger words will often make the other person do the opposite of what you are trying to accomplish. Instead use the words "yes and". The brain responds better to body movement, gesture, facial expression than more data. When making a presentation do not give off negative clues and tense up; just relax.
