He has served in many club functions, most notably club president in 2010-11 and his current role heading up Rotary International Foundation giving for our club. Until two years ago he ran the Minnesota operations for Smiths Medical. For the past two years Curt has been part of the global operations group for the company, interacting with all 13 plants throughout the world. Smiths Medical products have been in high demand since the beginning of the COVID 19 pandemic. Their plant in the UK makes ventilators, but the company also makes tracheotomy equipment, as well as products for airway management and lung capacity testing. The Minnesota plant makes blood oxygen monitors and infusion pumps for pain management and drug delivery. COVID 19 has been tough on the Lean Manufacturing efforts at the company but the focus on safety and social distancing in all production efforts is high. PROGRAM: Terry Wu, Neuromarketing

Terry's company focuses on how we make buying decisions based on feelings and emotions. He gave an example of how Coca Cola tried unsuccessfully to introduce a new formula, New Coke, and why it was poorly received. This caused consumers to really appreciate the old formula, which is now known as Coke Classic. He summarized the psychology of the Pepsi Challenge ad campaign and how the unconscious mind affects buying decisions. Neuromarketing is the science of consumer decisionmaking that uses our emotions such as pride, joy, happiness, guilt, shame, etc. along with our intuition to affect these decisions. Products fail because companies do not pay close enough attention to consumer's unconscious behavior. In one example, Google raised the "click rate" of their links simply be changing the shade of blue identifying the link. This change substantially raised Google's revenue because they are paid by the click. Another example is how Amazon uses reviews and shows consumers what others are buying to affect our buying decisions. Terry mentioned a book by Daniel Kahneman, "Thinking Fast and Slow" that illustrates how relativity bias and pricing items to sell affects buying decisions. Fast thinking is emotional and slow thinking is analytical. Our impulse purchases are based on emotion not analysis. You can get more information about Terry's company and neuromarketing at:
