## **Program:**

President Pat called upon Ann Frisch to introduce the program of the day. She recalled the work of Sharon Tennison, an American nurse who set out to assist in deescalating cold war tensions by attempting to bridge misunderstanding and fear between Americans and Russians by bringing citizen diplomats together through grass root exchanges and conversations about common interests. Results of her initiatives continue today through several exchanges of citizens promoting peace through understanding. Ann said she was delighted to introduce Nena Novomeyskaya and Vladimer Korsun of the Ekaterinburg, Russia Rotary Club with whom she has been conversing over the past two months and they in turn introduced six additional members of their club attending this meeting.

Ekaterinburg is the largest city in the administrative center of Sverdlovsk Oblast and the Ural Federal District. It is located on the Iset River in Western Siberia with a population of 1.5 million and a climate similar to MN. It and the 2.2 million urban agglomeration in which it is located is often referred to as the "Third Capital" of Russia due to its size, economy, culture, transportation and tourism. Their club was founded in 1998 with 18 members and has grown to 32. The club has been active in international exchanges with Rotary clubs in CA, NM, TX and Canada. It helps promote native art, an orphanage, a care clinic for disabled person, Para Olympics and has sponsored a youth club. Their formal introduction was followed by several questions and answers ranging from how COVID-19 is affecting their region to climate and economic development. The notion of a possible exchange of five members from each club surfaced from the conversation and there appeared to be significant interest from both clubs. At President Pat's suggestion/request Ann agreed to explore this idea further if she receives assistance from other club members. Sounds like a great start to a whole new peaceful and cultural exchange opportunity. If you have interest in pursuing this prospect contact Ann. Thanks for an interesting program!
