#### PROGRAM: Greg Bartz Presents: Gary Powers Jr.

Francis Gary Powers Jr.'s father was the famous U2 spy plane pilot shot down over Russia. He is a member of the James River Rotary Club in Richmond, VA and is on a Rotary International committee with Greg having to do with Russia. Gary gave presentations at New Richmond, WI and Stillwater on this topic recently. Gary's father was shot down while doing aerial photography of strategic defense sites in Russia. He was captured in Russia soon after he became disentangled from the damaged plane and parachuted 30,000 ft. to the ground. He was tried and convicted of espionage and sentenced to 10 years in a Russian prison. He was later freed in a prisoner exchange. He died in a helicopter crash while employed as news reporter in Los Angeles. Our presenter notes that there was much misinformation about this incident and when he found out that Spielberg was making a movie about it, was able to consult on the making of the film. Bridge of Spies was made in 2014-15 and Gary did his best to make sure the most accurate information was available to the film producers. Gary has written a book called Spy Pilot that used research from his father's diary, family, CIA, his father's co-workers, and other war veterans about the Cold War. While trying to find the true story of this incident, he founded a museum dealing with the Cold War, located 45 miles west of Washington DC in Vint Hill, VA. Gary noted that there is still much misinformation about this incident
