PROGRAM FROM MEETING OF 12/15/21: Giving Hope in Difficult Times Clergy panel of WBL Rotarians: Art Hancock--- Priest at St. John's the Wilderness Episcopal Church in WBL; Bill Eaves---Pastor at WBL United Methodist Church; Bob Gehrke--- Pastor at South Shore Lutheran Church in WBL

A few excerpts from the panel discussion lead by Moderator Mike Lovett: The panel shared their many challenges during the time of COVID including learning new ways to connect with people, the challenges of relationships, when and how to worship, difficulties connecting with people such as shut-ins, and the evolving question of community and connection. Reflecting on how this has affected the broader world, Bill shared the spiritual concern of whether our world will ever be the same, how do we cope, what is our place in the world, our relationship with God and how to make sense of it all. Art commented on the great sense of being unsettled, and that the church is a microcosm of what is happening world-wide. He reflected on what it means to be human to be in community, and that finding our way through in a meaningful way is a shared experience. Regarding grieving, Bob shared that many are grieving loss and that families need to take time to cry, remember, laugh, and share memories about what that person meant to them. He spoke of Faith, Hope and Love, and of living in a time of hope at Christmas. Bill added that hope is the foundational feeling that things will work out ok, even if I can't change my circumstances. Art talked about loss and brokenness being so hard and one can become paralyzed by it. Love and life are at the soul of the universe. Loss and death are seen as a way to touch life and love as well. He shared that faith is the confidence, that love is at the very soul of the universe, and hope is when we can experience it. We become conduits of that love. Others experience that love through us, such as through Rotary. Out of brokenness comes hope. Holidays are time to pause and reflect on hope. Mike thanked everyone at Rotary for the hope and support shown. Knowing someone cares and supports you is very important.
