<u>Program:</u> Jenny Moore, Director of White Bear High School Career Pathways Program

Jenny Moore, a director of Career Pathways Program at White Bear High School, gave an interesting and fast-paced talk about the Program. The purpose of Career Pathways is to align educational opportunities with workforce needs. It helps high school students (9-12) make informed decisions about their future career and/or college paths. The program is optional and offers pathways in 5 fields: Automotive, Construction, Health Care, Information Technology (IT), and Manufacturing. High school students enrolled in Career Pathway courses learn industry specific skills and may earn free college credit and industry-recognized credentials. Students are involved in hands-on classroom and field experiences, such as internships, connecting with local industry professionals, touring local business, and other learning opportunities. The students develop essential skills and experience needed to either enter the workforce directly or further their education at a two or four year post-secondary institution. 
