PROGRAM: Brady Ramsay presented Ken Smith, the President and CEO of Ever Green Energy Inc.

Ever-Green Energy helps the community secure its energy future. The company understands the complexity and nuances of developing and managing advanced energy systems. Ken discussed what it takes to deliver modern energy. The systems we rely on now are coal and nuclear. Coal as an energy source is expected to be shut down by 2030 and nuclear by 2040. We are now relying more on wind and solar. The system is changing fast. Since 2008 the 2 largest sources of energy will disappear (coal and nuclear); there is introduction of self-driving cars; solar is the fastest growing source of energy; 2:1 renewable to fossil fuels; wind is a source. Minnesota is the fastest growing state for solar in the country. Ammonia is a critical factor. Ammonia is being used in in farming for fuel and fertilizer. Energy has gone from a linear system to a very interconnected system. There will be infinitely data to manage. White Bear Lake is part of the Climate Smart Communities program. White Bear Lake is partnered with Ludenscheid Germany to speed progress toward a clean and more energy efficient footprint.

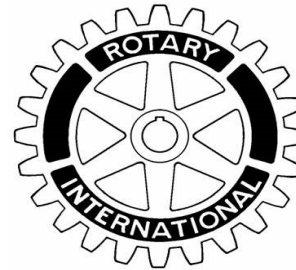
