Greg Cryer presented to the club from his home in South Africa on the Rotary Action Group for Family Health and AIDS Prevention. 3.5 billion people in the world lack access to adequate healthcare, and RFHA is dedicated to helping provide access. RFHA delivers this healthcare access through Rotary Family Health Days, which are massive health intervention programs that integrate screening, testing, treatment, immunization, etc.

These health intervention programs require RFHA to coordinate many different efforts – funding partners, media and marketing partners, medical providers, government health departments, and local volunteers all must work together to make these successful. To date, RFHA has served 2.5 million people and with over 11 million services provided.
