PROGRAM: Bob Timmons presents: Patrick (Packy) Mader

Patrick grew up on a dairy farm in St. Bonifacius and currently lives in Northfield. He has a background in education, business, and agriculture, is a huge sports fan and the author of six books. Two of those are Minnesota Gold, which profiles 57 Minnesota athletes, and More Minnesota Gold, which covers an additional 51 people. The books profile those who have been Olympians since 1948. Interviews with these individuals took him throughout the state. Since he started this project there have been 340 living Olympians from Minnesota. The majority (40%) have been hockey players; there is a higher representation from curling, but curling has been an Olympic sport for fewer

The five Olympic rings represent the continents (none for Antarctica as there is no population, and South and North America are represented by one ring as the Americas). The colors of the rings represent every color that appears in flags of countries throughout the world.
