**PROGRAM:** Mark Miller Presents: Phil McNairy, Israel Project

Prompted by the April 2018 Rotary Exchange which Mark Miller from our club was part of, Mr. McNairy talked about next year's exchange called the Israel Project. A past exchange brought forth an opportunity to partner with the Ort School in a town halfway between Jerusalem and Tele Aviv. The school warehoused students that the Israeli education system didn't know what to do with. Noting that there were some similarities between this school in Israel and our skill-based two year vocational program in Minnesota, members of the past exchange saw the potential for a partnership. Our vocational program educates students not interested in the four-year college career path, noting that many times nontraditional students are able to make valuable contributions to our society because of their technical skills and because they have more of a tendency to become small business owners. In connection with Ormat Industries which is involved in geothermal and green energy initiatives and leadership development, the Israel Project has formed a partnership to help Israeli schools to better educate their technical students by having representatives of administration, faculty, industry leaders, and students observe the education system and local culture here and to share information and keep in touch after the exchange.

Mr. McNairy is looking for Rotary partners in the Israel Project. The need for this year is \$10,000 to allow a Minnesota delegation of three or four people to go to Israel for ten days this spring and, so a delegation of three or four Israelis can come here for ten days in the fall. Currently, he has applied for a district grant from our district (5960) in the amount of \$4,500 and gotten a commitment from the Red Wing Rotary Club for \$3,000.
