<u>Program:</u> Jim Hunt presented Fast for Hope, an initiative sponsored by Rotary District 5960.

Dave Newman has been a Rotarian for almost 40 years and is the current chair of Fast for Hope. Their goal is to create a sustainable and replicable program to address poverty in developing countries. They have been working in El Corozo Nicaragua, since 2008. Nicaragua was one of the safest countries in this part of the world, but since April 2018 has been experiencing significant civil unrest which has affected the initiative's plans.

The initiative takes a wholistic approach, believing that there are a myriad of issues that keep a community in poverty and thus the work needs to be done on a community-wide basis rather than a focus on a specific project. Priority is given to building human capacity and developing community leaders, so that people learn to trust and believe in themselves and then move to working together as a community.

To date there have been 26 delegations of Rotary members, deep relationships are being built, and a new Rotary club has been established in El Corozo. Current activities focus on children (up to 5th grade), youth (leadership development), women (gender equity and health), and health care (pharmacy kits), as well as efforts to provide safe drinking water and books. Jim Hunt visited El Corozo this winter and described a process that allowed community members to "dream what you want to do." Groups of older residents and those of younger people came to similar conclusions – build a community center and a library.

Civil unrest continues, with protests, jailings, and deaths. The political polarization is more extreme than we currently see in the U.S. But El Corozo is peaceful and the leadership team has come back together. Fast for Hope has established benchmarks to determine if progress can continue to be made or if an orderly transition will need to occur.

Jim presented Dave with a check from White Bear Rotary in support of Fast for Hope.
