Program: Effiom Whyte, Rotary Club of Kingston, Jamaica

The Rotary Club of Kingston (RCOK) is our twin club and we have participated in many joint projects. Effiom Whyte, a pilot and aviation manager, has been a Rotarian for 16 years and was president of the Kingston Club in 2011-2012. The international theme that year was “Reach Within to Embrace Humanity”. In order to carry the theme forward, the Club started a “Transformation Through Signage” program in order to impact children, including infants, primary and high school students. At each of Kingston’s 48 schools, the Club erected a Rotary Four-Way Test sign, installed one water cooler near the Dean of Discipline’s Office, planted one breadfruit tree, and gave each student a bookmark with the Rotary Four Way Test inscribed upon it. The entire cost was \$2.5 million. Approximately 43,000 individuals were positively impacted with the Rotary signage. The first sign was installed at the Kingston High School with the Mayor of Kingston being present. On October 7, 2011, a tree planting took place at King’s House with Hon. Sir Patrick Allen, the Governor-General of Jamaica, planting 2 breadfruit trees. In June 2012, at the Kingston Clubs regular meeting, Hon. Portia Simpson-Miller, the Prime Minister of Jamaica, was named a Paul Harris Fellow and given a Rotary certificate and medallion. Effiom, thank you for this excellent program and all you do for Jamaica and the international community.
