PROGRAM: Avenues of Service, Club Service and International

Club Service: Pat Tschida talked about the duties -- basically, the administrative operations of the club, from keeping attendance to inducting new members and preparing them for membership. It also keeps track of attendance and does program planning, socials, Care Committee; accounts receivables.

International: Patty Hall and Greg Bartz talked about all that International does. Some of the highlights:

- -Currently, the gathering for North Korean refugees at Camp St. Croix. Our club chipped in \$3,000, got \$3,000 from other clubs, and the district matched the total with \$6,000 to make the camp happen. There are 18 refugees at camp from around the United States.
- -Our club is involved in a water hygiene project in Nigeria, involving three global grants to provide \$600,000 to work with 30 schools.
- -Open World -- Greg's pursuit -- continues to prosper, with our cultural connection to Krasnoyarsk and its people.
- -We have put up \$1,000 toward a rural health care initiative in Sierra Leone.
- -We have come alongside the Stillwater club to help with a well water project in Nicaragua.
- -We've given money to Century College and White Bear Lake middle schools to support cultural exchange programs.
- -Our club has money in a larger project at Nasaruni Academy in Kenya, where we are helping with water hygiene and related work.

Merchant Minute: Kate Cox, an instructor at White Bear Lake Sailing School, talked about the school's mission and her involvement. She is about to head to Mitchell Hamline School of Law and has a long history of sailing. The sailing school has 310 students and counting of all ages and abilities.
