Program: John Wayne Barker presents 21 Roots Farm (Grant, MN)

The mission of 21 Roots Farm is to provide a welcoming place where children and adults with developmental disabilities can experience farming opportunities. The nonprofit is run by Brittany Wiitala, Amy Peterson and Laura Lutz who currently volunteer their time. They obtained 21 acres in Grant in October 2018 and currently have cows, goats, horses, chickens, bee hives, and an apple orchard and hope soon to add pigs. They have initiated a number of different programs this summer including Fridays on the Farm, a 6-week program experiencing the animals and planting a garden; Farm Days for children, Monday-Thursday; and Wednesday evening classes. This fall they will have a Harvest Day in their apple orchard.

Laura described Farmer J who has a passion for cows and who will be training and showing a cow at next year's county fair. Farmer N, who has a number of garden plots at his home, has been teaching the staff the importance of labeling plants. Their Facebook page includes a number of stories and pictures of ways in which young people and adults are experiencing the farm and learning social skills.

There is a pole barn on the property with a heated floor and a shed with a commercial kitchen where they can process products. The group currently is seeking funds for a septic system (\$25,000). They plan to become sustainable over the long term through donations and sales of products.

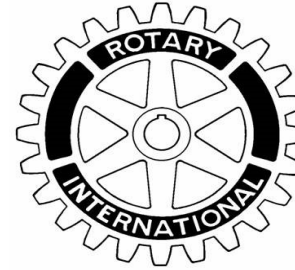

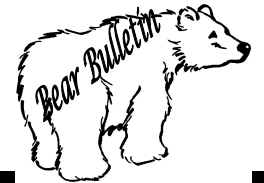
