With great enthusiasm, Wright talked about the beginnings of the Major Soccer League club, the building of its new stadium in St. Paul, and his expectations for the franchise. Wright, who's been boss of the club since October 2017 and is the onetime general manager of the Minnesota Kicks soccer team, has a long history in Twin Cities professional sports. He's been a top tier executive with the Minnesota Timberwolves and Lynx. He said Minnesota United already has made huge in-roads in a sports-saturated market, with a structure, vision and leadership team to deliver a great product on the field. He said the very first thing he did when he joined the club is get everyone, including an executive board stacked with business heavyweights like Bill McGuire and Glen Taylor, to identify the club's purpose. "What is our 'Why?' Wright said. Why are we here? Why will will be successful? He said the purpose of the team is to inspire and unite a diverse community that loves the game of soccer.

Here, at a glance, is how the team is trying to inspire:

—The \$250 million Allianz Field stadium will open in St. Paul's Midway neighborhood in mid-February 2019.

— The team is bidding for the 2020 or 2021 MLS All-Star Game.

— The U.S. men's team will play at Allianz next year, its first game since failing to qualify for the 2018 World Cup.

— The team is working with neighborhood businesses, churches and others on developing the area around the stadium.

— The team sold out it's season tickets (14,500) in under 14 minutes.

— The team signed the electrifying Darwin Quintero of Colombia, one of the top 5 players in the league, Wright said.

— The fan experience is paramount. They already are establishing traditions, like singing "Wonderwall" by Oasis after victories.


