5 Stones Media is a Minnesota faith- based nonprofit organization which provides hope and healing for those who need change by providing videos of survivor stories. Steve Johnson, a television producer, and 4 of his friends founded this organization to bring hope and redemption to those in prison or halfway houses. 5 Stones ,with the help of may therapists and counselors, developed a successful 9 step 12 week program to help prison inmates find transformation and redemption. The company first produced the Turnipseed Trilogy about the life of John Turnipseed, a former Minneapolis gang leader and drug dealer, who had a life-changing turnaround fueled by his passion for rebuilding relationships between fathers and their families. The Trilogy was so successful that the company is now producing life support survivor programs for family members who are hurting because of loss of a child, loss of a parent, or mental illness and sexual exploitation.
