PROGRAM: Mark Sather Rotary Park Nature Preserve

Rotarian Mark Sather presented on the history of the Rotary Park Nature Preserve. The story of the park actually goes back to White Bear Lake's changing community in the 1960's and 70's in which the city's population grew dramatically and how the city responded to the need for industrial development. Local residents were concerned about the threat of too much industrial development, and the Rotary Club had the idea to purchase the land from developers and turn the area into a nature preserve.

The area became a nature preserve with a regional trail running through it in the late 1980's, thanks to a collaborative effort including state grants, the DNR, and the city of White Bear Lake. The Rotary Club has spearheaded several improvement projects to the park throughout the years.

In 1993, Rotarians built the restroom structure.

In 2000, Rotarians built the log construction pavilion building. This project was designed by Bill Rust's firm, and assembled by Rotary club members. Questions about whether this project was inspired by a desire for community service or motivated by a large group of Rotarians hitting a simultaneous mid-life crisis still remain unanswered. The project's completion was pushed along by then president Tim Geck's promise of a steak dinner; further investigation has uncovered that this dinner has not yet occurred.

Next, the Rotary Club build a boardwalk through the wetland areas of the park, giving community members greater walking access in the nature preserve.

Lastly, the Rotary Club volunteers each year around Arbor Day gather to plant trees, clean up litter, and remove invasive species.

In total, the Rotary Club has donated over \$85,000 and countless volunteer hours to this park.
