<u>Program:</u> Sara Hanson White Bear Lake Area Historical Society (WBLAHS)

The White Bear Lake Area Historical Society (WBLAHS) was formed 50 years ago with the mission "to connect the community to its past". Its motto is " Save History". The Society, with offices and research library in the White Bear Armory on 4th Street, concentrates its efforts on the 5 cities which surround White Bear Lake: City of White Bear Lake, Town of White Bear, Dellwood, Mahtomedi, and Birchwood. Sara Hanson became the first executive director in 2001. Memberships and fundraisers are the Society's main source of income and determines the services and programs it can provide to the community. Some of the services and programs include the operation of the Fillebrown House which it owns, Pops on the Porch, Holiday Events, Victorian Teas, the White Bear Walking Tour, the White Bear Historical House Tour, the Depot Museum, White Bear Town Hall, the Boating Tour, the Trail Marker Tour, the Gangster Bus Tour, the Research Library, Photographs and Prints, Special Exhibits and Programs.

To celebrate its 50 years, it will have an online celebration from

September 25 through September 28 presented as "50 for 50 – Celebrating 50 Years of the WBLAHS", a 50- hour virtual event featuring an online segment each hour that showcases various aspects of the community's history. The online segments will include live and prerecorded sections on Wildwood Amusement Park, White Bear Gangsters, the Johnson Boat Works story, Cass Gilbert's White Bear Cottages, White Bear hockey history, and more.
